

## **President Ram Nath Kovind arriving tomorrow on a two-day visit**

The President Ram Nath Kovind is arriving in Agartala next morning on a two-day visit to the state. He will be landing at the Agartala airport next morning. After a guard of honour to the President he will head for Udaipur in helicopter. There at a function at Rajarshi Town Hall he is scheduled to ceremonially inaugurate the highway from Matabari to Sabroom and will address the public. Later at noon, the President will be laying the foundation stone of re-development of Matabari complex. Then he will have a look around the Matabari temple complex and then he will be on his way back to Agartala. Then he will take rest at the Raj Bhawan and in the evening a civic reception will be organized in his honour at Rabindra Shata Barshiki Bhawan. In this event he will declare the Queen Variety pineapple as 'the state fruit'. After spending the night at Raj Bhawan he will be leaving the state next morning.

## **HS Arts and Commerce Results to be out on 8 June**

Tripura Board of Secondary Examination (TBSE) will declare the Higher Secondary Examination 2018 results of Arts and Commerce streams and Fazil Theology and Fazil Arts examinations on 8 June, 2018 (Friday) at 9:30 am through a press conference in the conference hall of the

Board. It is mentioned here that heads of concerned schools or their designated representatives can collect the mark-sheets and certificates of the students of their concerned schools from the centres as mentioned in the notification published in the newspapers of 20 and 21 May, 2018. Alongwith the mark sheets annual calendar and specimen copy of review application (including last date) will be there. The deputy secretary of Tripura Board of Secondary Examination in a notification has informed this.

## **Elbert Ekka memorial park commissioned**

A park in memory of the martyr Elbert Ekka was inaugurated by the Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb yesterday at Lichubagan, Agartala. An amount of over Rs. 1.22 crore has been spent in raising the park spreading over 1.99 acre. the park has come up under



the supervision of the forest department. Inaugurating the park the Chief Minister said, we are proud to be living in the country where brave personalities like Elbert Ekka are born. Reminiscing the valour and dedication with which Ekka fought in

the 1971 against the Pakistani forces the Chief Minister paid homage to the martyr on behalf of the people of Tripura.

The Chief Minister also informed that a statue of Ekka would be installed near the entry point to the park later on. Apart from that statues of some other martyrs will also be installed with proper descriptions in Bengali, Kaborok and English so that the people and students in particular could read them and know about their lives.

It is worth mentioning here that the park has a walking trail of 1.5 km. There are also two open resting sheds for the visitors and adequate space for children. The artificial lake, statue of Hozagiri dancer, sculptural fineries in the pattern of Unakoti, water fountain etc. will definitely entertain the visitors. Speaking as the chief guest of the occasion Dr. Dilip Das, MLA, emphasized on keeping the park clean.

### **State level Vanamahotsav observed:**

69<sup>TH</sup> state level Vanamahotsav was inaugurated by the Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb at Eklabya Model Residential School on June 5. C.M expressed that this is the first time in the state that World Environment Day and State level Vanamahotsav were being observed together on the same day. For this reason CM cordially congratulated the forest department. He said that during the last 25 years opium plantation was being done

illegally by destroying the forest of the state. As a result the state had been affected financially and at the same time young generation was also moving towards



destruction. The government is encouraging the tribal people in cultivation of pineapple and bamboo for strengthening economic base of the state. If bamboo is produced in large scale in the state a bamboo-based industry could also be developed.

The Chief Minister stated that best pineapple of the world is being produced in our state. Already we have exported one tonne pineapple to Dubai. Now cultivators are getting value of their produce (pineapple) directly. As a result they are being benefitted. A food processing industry based on pineapple could also be built up. BJP-IPFT Government has already started working towards this. Besides this, the government has taken initiative for plantation in large scale throughout the State during the months of June-July, 2018

for conservation of forest. Appealing to everybody to be conscious about keeping the environment pollution-free he requested all to plant a tree in their house. In this function Forest Minister Mevar Kumar Jamatia expressed that it was not possible to save forest by the forest department alone or on the part of the police administration. Everybody must come forward in the mission. Among others present on the occasion were MLA Kalyani Roy, MLA Pinaki Pal Choudhury, MLA Prasanra Debbarma, MLA Dr. Atul Debbarma and Tulashikar BAC Chairman Pradip Debbarma. PCCF Dr. Atul Kumar Gupta delivered welcome speech in the function. Social and social education, education, forest, health and agriculture department and Tulashikar Block opened exhibition stalls in the event.

### **C.M at review meeting: Initiative to launch Agartala-Deoghar Express**

The Union Ministry of Railways has decided on the train to be used to commence Agartala-Deoghar Express service. Now, date for launching of the train will be finalized after consultation with the Railway Ministry. Initiative has to be taken to launch Agartala-Deoghar Express service within the 100 days programme. Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb asserted this in the review meeting of Transport department held on June 4 in the conference hall no-1 of Civil Secretariat.

Additional secretary of the transport department informed that work of internal drainage system up-gradation had been

started by the department under 100 days programme in Inter-state Truck Terminus at Madhabbari of Jirania. The Chief Minister instructed the transport department to complete the work as soon as possible. Additional secretary of transport department informed that up-gradation of Agartala Airport was going on. State government has spent Rs. 38 crore 13 lacs for acquisition of land. Airport Authority of India has sanctioned Rs.438 crore for this project. It was also informed that at present there are 4 lacs 42 thousand 331 vehicles in the state. Rs.53 crore 38 lacs 15 thousand 657 has been collected as revenue during the period of 2017-18. 18 buses of Tripura Road Transport Corporation are plying on different routes of the state. Apart from this 119 buses under Tripura Urban Transport Corporation Ltd. are plying on 24 routes. In the review meeting Transport Minister Pranajit Singha Roy and other officials were also present.

### **World Environment Day Observed in Longtharai Valley**

The “Think Global, act local” policy is considered effective in protection of environment and on this belief 5<sup>th</sup> June of every year is observed as “World Environment Day”. This year also the day has been observed in Longtharai Valley Sub-division along with the nation.
