

## Maayer Ashirwaad attains national recognition of 'Best Performing SHG'

Today the Best Performing SHGs under National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM) were felicitated in New Delhi. Organised by the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India an SHG namely Maayer Ashirwaad from Jolaibari block of South Tripura district has received National Award as one of the Best Performing SHGs in this felicitation ceremony. Narendra Singh Tomar, Union Minister of Rural Development, Panchayati Raj and Mines graced the occasion as the



chief guest while Ram Kripal Yadav, Union Minister for Rural Development and Land Resources was present as the guest of honour. Rajlaxmi Banik, Internal Community Resource Person (ICRP) shared her experience on this national stage.

The National Award winning SHG was a venture of 12 poor women formed in 2013 under SGSY and came under the fold of

NRLM in 2015. With a humble beginning of Rs. 20 contribution made by its members now every member contributes Rs. 60 per week. With its activities in the field of fishery, mushroom cultivation, small trade, agricultural activities, gottary, kitchen garden etc. Maayer Ashirwaad has already received second gradation and credit linkage was sanctioned on August 1, 2017.

Why Maayer Ashirwaad is singled out is also because of its welfare-centric activities. So far many times they have extended helping hand to many poor of the village; they have given financial and physical contribution to conduction of marriage ceremony in the village, as well as they have left their mark by joining the Swachh Bharat Mission more often than not. Thus this is not just an SHG but a medium of poor women's empowerment.

## Administrative camp held in Malsadhupara

Heads of the concerned schools or their designated representatives can collect the mark-sheets and certificates of the students of their schools from the centres as mentioned in the notification published in the newspapers of 20 and 21 May, 2018. Alongwith the marksheets annual calendar and specimen copy of review application (including the last date) will be there. This information was given by the Tripura Board of Secondary Education.

In this programme a target has been set for providing power connections to 6664 houses in the first phase under this district. According to the target 973 houses in Melaghar electricity subdivision, 326 houses in Nalchar area, 434 houses in Kathalia area, 53 houses in Sonamura area, 258 houses in Boxanagar area, 1249 houses in Jampuijala area, 67 houses in Madhupur area and 260 houses in Bishalgarh electricity subdivision will be provided power connections.
